School Uniform

As you may have realised, JSSK have now closed their doors for the final time. We would like to thank Paula and her team for their support over the many years they have been our uniform supplier. Hopefully many parents have made the most of the sale and stocked up on uniform for the new term.

We are now able to inform parents that Lyndale Sports will be a uniform supplier for us moving forwards. In appointing Lyndale, we looked at several off-island suppliers, but felt that the costs and convenience meant that a local supplier was preferable. We have already been working with Lyndale to get stock of our uniform in place, this is ongoing, but they are confident over the coming weeks stock will be available. In the short term at least, you will be able to order items from their website for collection from school or their shop. They will not yet have the full range on display in the shop, but will have items for you to try on and order the correct size. We are hoping to have items in school for you to see too in the short term.

All current uniform items will remain acceptable. However, following parental feedback and the new Education Department policy, we have made a few minor changes to the new uniform.

- The navy polo shirts will be discontinued (replaced by the current sky-blue ones for PE and non-PE).
- The school tracksuits will be discontinued (replaced by a logoed navy sweatshirt and non-branded leggings/joggers in winter).
- All-black trainers are now acceptable for non-PE days. This reflects our desire for children to be active and means children wearing this item do not need separate trainers. This will also save families money, as only one pair of shoes are needed. (Separate PE trainers are still acceptable, see below).

Uniform Item	Note
Navy branded and logo jumper OR Navy branded and logo cardigan	No change from current items
Sky-blue logo polo shirt	Children with sensory needs can wear a non-logoed item.
Navy Trousers OR Navy Skirt OR Navy pinafore dress OR Navy shorts or Navy Skort (summer)	No change, no branding- available from any supplier.
Navy socks (white socks in summer with shorts/dresses)	No change, no branding- available from any supplier.
Royal Blue/White striped summer dress	No change, no branding
Black school shoes OR all-black and unbranded black trainers	These must be all black - white soles like sneaker/Converse style, or bright coloured additions/branding are not acceptable. They must also be safe and suitable for PE (e.g not 'wedge' style soles).
Art apron	Old over-sized t-shirt is perfect for this, no need to buy a bespoke item unless you want to
PE Uniform Item	Note
Sky blue logo polo shirt OR existing navy logo shirt	We are not replacing the navy polo at Lyndale. This is to save costs for parents, so parents only need to buy the sky blue ones.
Navy stripe PE shorts	No change, no branding

Navy/white socks	No change, no branding- available from any supplier.
Navy logo sweatshirt OR existing logo tracksuit top	This was changed following parental feedback with the new item being stocked by Lyndale.
Navy joggers or leggings (for winter wear) OR existing tracksuit trousers	Unbranded- available from any supplier.
All-black trainers (with black soles and no bright colours/bright branding) OR other trainers. Both need to be sports shoes not fashion items.	Parents can choose to send children every day in black trainers rather than have separate school shoes. This is designed to save costs for parents and support active play.

Our second-hand shop will continue to sell items we have had donated. Please see a flyer from Lyndale with more information about uniform.
