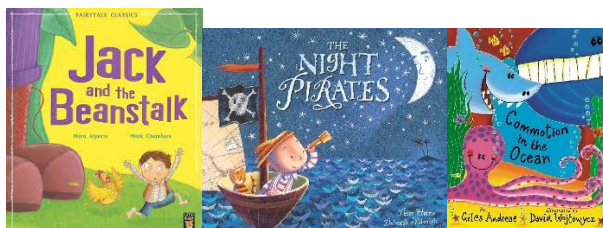

The following text drivers will be used this half term to ignite a passion for reading and provide some hooks for writing, **Night Pirates**, **Commotion in the Ocean** and **Jack and the Beanstalk**. Each book will be explored as a focus text and the opportunities for learning will be evident in all areas of provision.

Maths

This half term we will focus on the following: subitising. Adding and subtracting, doubling, odd and even numbers and number bonds/composition of numbers to 10. We also revisit and consolidate the following skills; counting beyond 20 (not stationary objects) and number recognition and formation, comparing and ordering numbers.
