We will compare and contrast the human and physical geographical features of Jersey and Australia, looking at weather patterns, landmarks and animals.

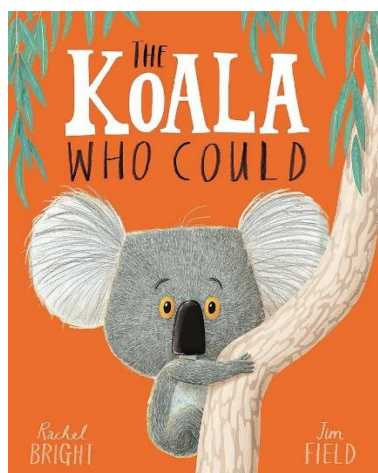
In Science we will learn about plants that grow in Australia and about the life cycle of plants. We know this will be a brilliant topic and we are also excited that

we have an expert in Year 2 – Mrs Butler lived in Australia for 10 years!



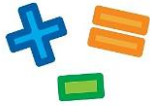
Australia

This half term, our text driver is 'The Koala Who Could' written by Rachel Bright. We will use this book to help us practise our oracy skills, rehearsing and performing it as a script. This will also help us develop these skills ready for our Christmas nativity!

The children will be writing a short re-tell of the story from Kevin's point of view. After they have written their stories they will read them to check for sense and practise their editing skills.



Maths

This half term we will focus on addition and subtraction. The children will continue to learn their number bonds as well as learn about 'fact families' and the relationships between numbers. We will continue to use tens frames, part whole diagrams and lots of practical resources to help support the children's learning.

Caring Cooks

This half term we will be participating in Caring Cooks sessions. Over the course of 5 weeks we will learn to create different seasonal dishes and get the chance to try new foods. Nativity!

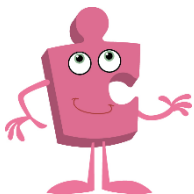
