Our tree is also full of valentine cards because we ran out of space in the nook! It's funny how there were a lot of misty eyes from the staff remembering their favourites.




ILLUSTRATION CHALLENGE

We had some wonderful entries but our winners were Aubrey Moore in Key Stage 2 and Waheed Hussain in Key Stage 1. Look out for them in the future!




500 WORDS CHALLENGE
