Our winners were:

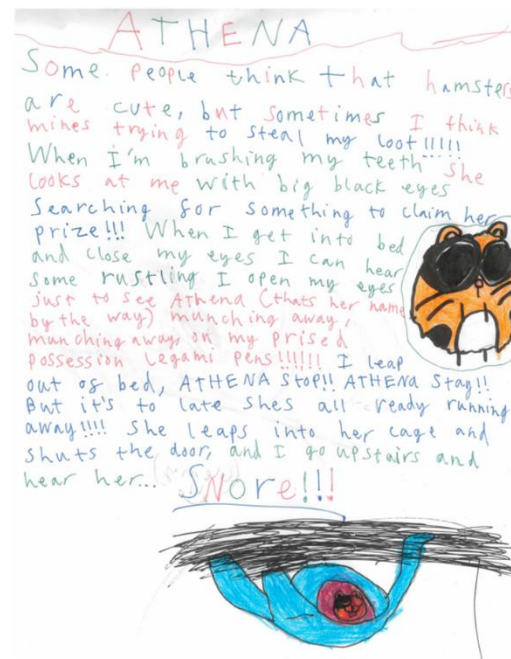
Bella – Reception

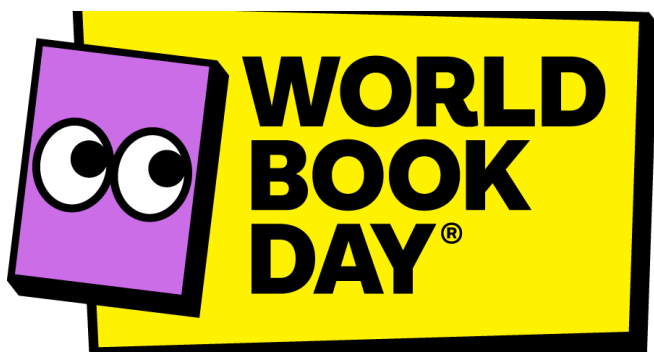


If you don't know Spike Milligan's poems, they are really worth having a look.
