### Topic



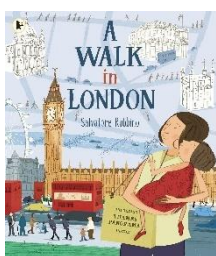
Throughout our topic of 'Islands' we will be delving into knowledge about different islands, examining how islands form and comparing islands in different areas, looking at the similarities and differences between them. We will compare populations, weather and industries.

### Art

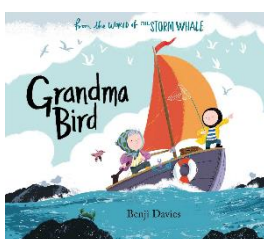


During this half term the children will focus on 3D sculptures by Jersey artists. They will use their construction skills to make clay sculptures of fish and houses.

### English



Our first Text Driver is A Walk in London which focuses on the information we get from non-fiction books. We will be looking at the book and comparing what we learn about London to our parish of St Brelade. What things could we walk around and see? The children will then be using their own knowledge to write a factual leaflet about Jersey and places we can see and visit around the island.



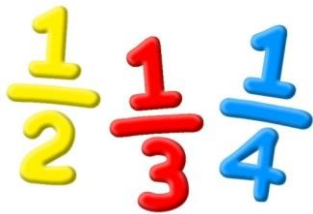
Our second Text Driver this term is Grandma Bird. This book is set on a remote island, which will continue to inspire us as we learn about Sark. We will also be learning more about drawing conclusions by developing our inference skills.

Throughout the last term we have been looking at using the past tense and the children have been practising these spellings and using the words in sentences. However, as we have been doing this work, we have noticed that many children are not using the past tense correctly in their speech, and therefore not able to use it or write it correctly. For example, saying 'caught' instead of 'caught', 'falled' instead of 'fell' or 'writted' instead of 'wrote'. If you hear your child using the past tense incorrectly in their speech, then please gently correct them and remind them of the right word to use. It will really help us in helping them to achieve their literacy goals.

## Teach Handwriting

We are continuing to focus on handwriting and presentation this term, with a big focus on joining our handwriting all the time. If you want to see some of the handwriting resources, they are freely available at [teachhandwriting.co.uk](http://teachhandwriting.co.uk).

### Maths



This half term we are learning about fractions. The unit provides a review of previously learnt concepts and then we move on to find fractions of whole numbers and quantities. The unit focuses on halves, quarters and thirds. We will compare and order fractions and learn to count in quarters and thirds and finish the unit by finding parts of a set.

### PE



Just a reminder that PE days this half term are as follows:

#### **Tuesday and Wednesday**

P.E sessions will be continuing to focus on developing skills needed to help us in our Sports Day. We are learning how to safely jump hurdles, throwing and hitting targets, working as a team, as well as showing off our individual skills.

### PSHE



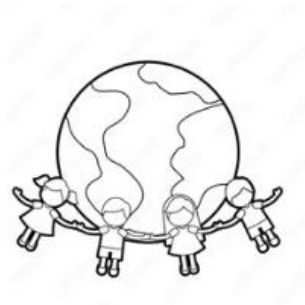
