Minutes

Welcome

(Charlotte)

Approval of Last Minutes

(Charlotte)

We will look at maybe running the fair this year from lunchtime as the food stall was only busy for a small time and also look at different ideas regarding what food to serve as may be best to sell coffee and cake. We will also look at running the cafe off of a room from the hall and have seating. The grotto worked really well as there was no set up involved so will look to do again this year. 150 children were seen and buying tickets for a time slot worked really well. We will also give books out again as the quality was great.

Treasurer's Report

The Accounts have been done, just chasing two cheque stubs from a couple of years ago from when the previous committee were in place. Nicole will go to the bank this week to sort out.

Banking Issues

(Charlotte)

Forms that were signed have been sent back as there were a couple of parts missing. It was agreed for John Baudains, Dave McAllister, Charlotte Sewrey, Sophie Heslop and perhaps Carol Houillebecq to be signatories. **Charlotte** will speak to Carol to check she is happy with this. **Charlotte** will speak to Kelly and Carey in their capacity as Treasurers to check they are happy with this also.

Movie Night

It was agreed to hold a movie night on Thursday 13 February rather than a Valentine's Disco and hold a Leaver's Disco instead in the Summer. We will show Toy Story 4 and **Charlotte** will source the DVD for the event. It was agreed to charge £2 for entrance and ice cream. We will look to sell 150 tickets as this is maximum capacity for the hall so ticket sales will be on a first come first served basis. **Charlotte** will get in touch with Jersey Dairy to see if we can get reduced cost pots of ice cream and **Charlotte** will print the tickets.

Family Quiz Night

Tim is a Quiz Master and has very kindly agreed to run a quiz on Thursday 12 March at the school. The quiz will be child and adult friendly. The total length of the quiz would be 1 hour 20 minutes but will have breaks in between.

Ideas for later in the year include changing the Summer Fair as there is a lot of work with low profit. Instead, we would look at parents to attend school to look at the children's work and hold something on a smaller scale that day. Having an event on the same day as sports day is too much. The PTA will also fund ice lollies for the children on Sports Day.

We are also looking at holding an outdoor family movie night in the Summer on the school field. **Sophie** will get in touch with Kevin Lewis regarding a screen and check options.

We will hold the Mother and Father's Day Stalls again, **Sophie** will put a poster together to push for unwanted gifts.

Fund Requests**(John)**

The stage lighting has been purchased. **John** will check with Carol if the PTA have repaid the school for the purchase.

Regarding the wildlife cameras where funding has already been approved, they will need to be wired in and so this is ongoing. **Dave** to advise the PTA when payment will need to be made.

It was previously discussed at meetings last year to fund-raise for a new mini bus. As we would need any new drivers to now do courses to drive the buses (at the cost of the school) and it makes more sense to use coaches, this plan will currently be put on hold.

Instead it was agreed to fund raise for a new school library to include furniture and books. John showed us some great pictures from a company called Incube who have redesigned many school libraries in Jersey already and also the town library. The website is www.incube.ltd.uk and **John** will advise once he has a quote and we will hold another meeting to specifically discuss this. We could also look at businesses/ families donating to have their names on a plaque on any furniture or books.

It was reiterated that any requests for funds from teachers need to go through John first.

Any Other Business

(All)

Ken advised that there is a lot of fruit left over on a Friday. It was agreed that **John** will get the Student Counsel to survey the children to see if they would like any changes. It was discussed that we could have fruit the last Friday of each month and also change this up with smoothies, cheese and biscuits, etc instead.
